Food for Pupils Who Are Entitled to Free School Meals (Not Universal Free School Meals for YR, Y1 and Y2 children)

For next week, we have decided to provide each child who is currently entitled to free school meals, under the pupil premium scheme, with a bag of healthy groceries. Friday's announcement by the Government and the overwhelming demand on food supplies has meant that this has not been an easy task. There is no choice over the contents of the grocery bag and these may be subject to change, however, we anticipate each bag will contain:

Hovis White Bread	1 x Loaf
Baked Beans in tomato sauce	1 x tin
Heinz Spaghetti in Tomato sauce	1 x tin
Tuna Chunks in Brine	1 x tin
Fruitpot	1 x Fruit Pot
Jacket Potatoes in a sealed bag	(approx. 5 in a bag)
Bananas 1 KG	(approx. 4)

To collect your child's grocery bag please come to the back door, by the staff car park, **on Wednesday 25th March between 9.30am and 10:00am**, you will be asked to sign to confirm receipt. To help reduce the spread of Coronavirus we ask that you take the following precautions:

- please wash your hands before coming to the school site
- if there is queue please keep a distance between your group and another
- if you or anyone in your household has any symptoms of Coronavirus (a high temperature and a new, continuous cough) please do not come to school, send a friend instead

We will contact you next week to let you know the arrangements for the following week.
