CanDo Maths Daily Workouts

All the resources have been designed to help your child practise the maths topics they have learnt this year and make sure their maths skills stay healthy and strong. The idea is that you pick one or two Workouts for your child to complete each day – for example one 'Do It' and one 'Problem' Workout or just one 'Problem'. These have been added to the school website under 'Home Learning' and more will be added as they are released.



Numbots & Times Tables Rock Stars

Numbots is an add-on website to Times Tables Rock Stars and is aimed at 5-8 year olds to help develop fluency in mathematics skills. All children across the school can access this website using their TT Rockstars log in. Times Tables Rock Stars is used to help the children learn and practise their times tables and related division facts. More information on both is on the school website under 'Home Learning'. Maths with Parents

Maths with Parents is an online platform to support effective home learning for primary school children. 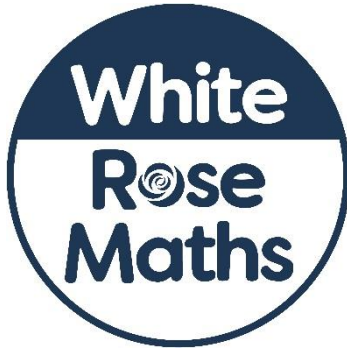

Number Stacks – Free 28 Day Trial

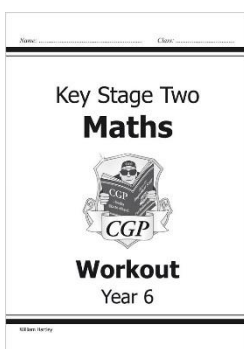
