Dear Parents and Carers,

We wanted to inform you that there are going to be some changes in relation to free school meals vouchers, over the next few weeks.

- 1) There will not be a voucher during May half term – next week
- 2) All FSM families will receive a voucher for week beginning 1st June
- 3) Y2, Y3, Y4, Y5, Y6 children will receive a voucher for week beginning 8th June
- 4) Y2, Y3, Y4, Y5 children will continue to receive their vouchers each week, as these year groups have not yet been invited back into school at this stage

These changes are due to the Government inviting more year groups back into school and therefore not being able to provide Edenred vouchers moving forward.

If you have decided not to send your child back to school, but would like to receive a packed lunch each day for your child/children you need to let us know as soon as possible.

We have tried calling you all, but we have not had many responses. Please email the school office – hwoffice@riverscofe.co.uk to let them know if you do or do not want to have a daily packed lunch. If we do not hear from you by Monday 25th May, we will assume that you do not want a packed lunch.

The lunches will be available for you to pick up from school each day, at the back door in the staff car park, at 11:45am.

These vouchers/packed lunches are only available to families who meet the FSM criteria and have been awarded FSM by County. If you think you might now meet the criteria, please contact County.
