Tuesday 26th May 2020

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please read carefully. If you have any questions please contact hwyear6@riverscofe.co.uk

- Pod 1, Pod 2 and Pod 3 children are planned to start back at school, full time, on Monday 15th June
- Pod 1 will be with Mrs Kingston in 6BK – children enter by class fire door
- Pod 2 with Mr Partridge in 6TEP – children enter by class fire door
- Pod 3 with Miss Spittle in 5DS – children enter by class fire door
- Drop off at 8:35am – staff car park, side gate – do not to be late – observe social distancing rules – 2 metres
- Home time at 3:15pm – staff car park, side gate - please observe social distancing rules – 2 metres
- Only one adult per family for pick up and drop off
- Each Friday, school closes at 12:00 – collect from car park gate – key worker children only until 3:15pm if needed
- School uniform – please wash daily
- If children are not in school, but were expected, there will be attendance calls made by the school office
- If children are poorly and won't be in school, please let the office know by 9:15am at the latest - 69750
- School Packed lunches available for all FSM children – children will bring it home with them on a Friday
- Children to bring own lunches if you have opted out of a school packed lunch
- Lunches from home to be completely disposable – everything to go in the bin – no lunch boxes or bags
- FSM vouchers from Edenred are stopping – last one w/b 1st June – no voucher in half term
- FSM children who are not returning to school can collect a lunch from school – hwoffice@riverscofe.co.uk
- Children to bring in own snack for break time – please make sure they can open it themselves
- Children must not bring in school bags, books, PE kit, school diaries etc to reduce risk of cross contamination
- Children must not bring in their phones
- All children need a coat and sunhat; please put sun lotion on before school
- Should your child be ill or show symptoms of Covid-19, they must not come to school
- If children become ill at school they will be put into isolation, an adult must collect them straight away
- If a child or any member of their family test positive for Covid, the Pod will close for 14 days
